It is about driving too hard without knowing where you are going.

Speed as a substitute for identity.

The engine stays on because stopping means asking a question you are not ready to answer.

I wrote it before I counted the lines.

When I counted the lines, I understood why the song needed to exist.

A count is not an argument.

333,000 lines does not tell you whether the work is good.

It does not tell you whether it will find anyone.

What it tells you is that the work happened.

That is the part I keep forgetting.

The folder contains a website.

A music archive — three figures, twenty-four public tracks, a room called Signal where you type a command and it plays.

Research threads on markets, cities, mergers, a film idea about where things come from before they have a name.

A local operating system that exists to disappear into the background.

Tools that build and publish and check.

A live pilot in progress — Pizza4People, a protocol for food access that does not ask permission from the platforms that usually own the room.

Thirty-something articles.

Most of it is not visible yet.

Fast Fast Fast ends with a stop.

The engine cuts.

Silence.

Then whatever comes next.

Today is the first of May.

The sun is out.

I am going outside in a few minutes.

I think that is where I am.
